Most skaters wanting to play hockey should be ready to move into this class. The program is designed to teach the fundamentals of hockey skating. All elements are taught without a stick or puck. Participants will need to wear hockey skates and an ice- approved certified hockey helmet. **NO MAKEUPS FOR THIS CLASS.**

The *Basic Skills* program is designed by the USFSA to help the skater learn all the fundamentals of figure skating and hockey. The registration fee includes sport accident insurance for the skater, a record book, and badges. After completion of a skill level the skater will receive a certificate

The *Snowplow Sam* program is for tots ages 5 and under. The basics of ice skating are taught in a safe and nurturing environment. Your child will also develop the basic coordination necessary to move on to the Basic Skills level.

The *Basic Skills* program teaches skaters ages 6-adult the basic fundamentals of ice skating. The eight levels of the program introduce the fundamental moves-forward skating, backward skating, stops, edges, crossovers, turns and beginning jumps and spins.

The *Free Skate* program is divided into four sections: Moves in the field, Dance/Footwork sequence, Spins and Jumps. The free skate program follows the completion of Basic Skills 8.

The *Ice Dance* program teaches skaters the first six dance patterns in the US Figure Skating test structure. Dances can be skated solo or with a partner. The ice dance program follows the completion of Basic Skills 5.
