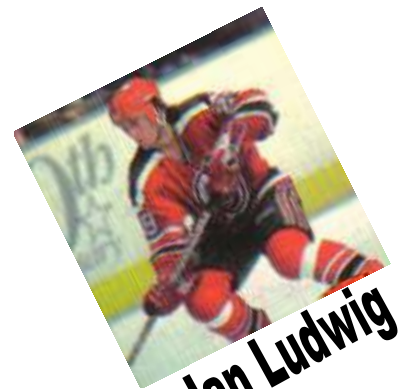
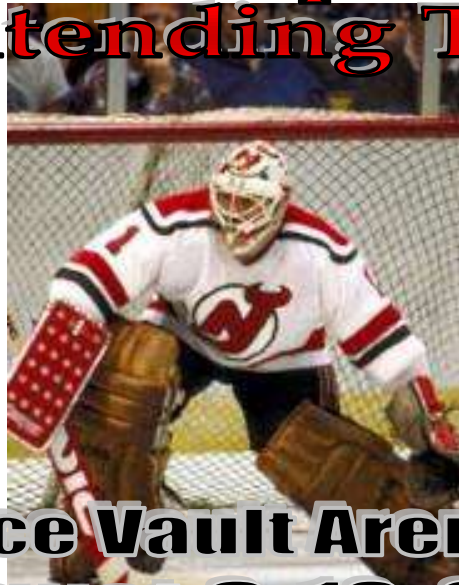

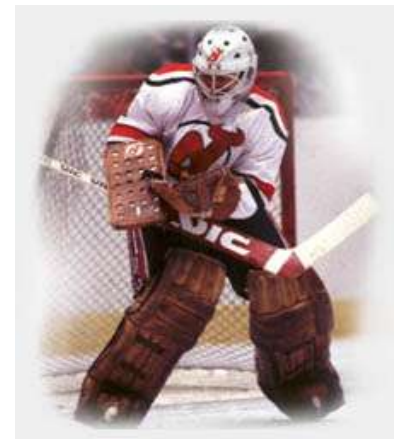
The camp is also designed towards forwards and defensemen exploring the weaknesses and specific spots to shoot against the goaltender. David Clarkson, Jan Ludvig and Jim Hunt will also be going through specific drills and stations with all shooters such as shooting strategy, quick release and accuracy.

The Objective

To get a unique view into the problem solving techniques faced by goaltenders in game situations. The on ice aspect of the camp is going to be conducted as circuit training and stations, with each station being composed of a certain number of goaltenders and a certain number of shooters. Each station is going to be working on a different set of drills and situations.

This camp is going to teach the following

- Basic goaltending stance and positioning of both gloves and pads
- Goaltenders movement in and around the crease
- Goaltender specific skating and use of the different edges
- Different ways of going down and getting up
- Reference points for goaltenders
- Passing, shooting, clearing the ice by goaltenders
- Ways of stopping the puck on a shoot around
- Dealing with 1:0, 1:1, 2:1, 3:1, 3:2
- Reading the play and cross the crease movement
- Importance of communicating between the goaltender and defensemen
- Ways of making the shooter commit before the goaltenders does
- Importance of following the puck with your eye after making a save
- Agility, flexibility, general athleticism specific to goal tenders

I believe that in the development of goaltenders, instructors need to look towards the NHL to see what style is effective in today's competition; then look at an individual's personal talents and skills towards combining the two to become the best possible for your game, whatever the individual level of play.

Having fun while playing goal happens once a goaltender can learn to effectively stop more pucks. At our camp, you will have fun while learning the steps needed to stop more pucks.
