Learn To Skate
Bridge Skating Program

Ice Vault Arena is offering an innovative new Learn to Skate program along with our Basic Skills Program. The “Bridge Program” is a means of introduction into competitive recreational skating. This program has been designed for motivated skaters wanting to advance their skills in an accelerated lesson environment. Skaters who have passed **Basic Skills 3 through Free Skate 6**, and have been recommended by your instructor are encouraged to participate in our “Bridge Program”.

To ensure appropriate class placement the Skating School Director must evaluate all skaters wanting to enroll in the Bridge Program before the start of the class session.

The Bridge program is on Saturday mornings or Tuesday afternoons during the Freestyle Session. During this hour the students will receive a ½ hr instruction, and a ½ hr practice time.

No Makeups for these classes.

Does not include Skate Rental, skate rental fee \$3.00 per class.

This program is best as a supplement to Learn to Skate classes and or private lessons. However, the Bridge Program can be done on its own merit with no additional instruction. But please note, that the classes do not cover sequential skill by skill Basic Skills badge earning instruction that Learn to Skate or private lessons provides.
